The company will more than double the size of its operations facilities.

During the groundbreaking ceremony Stephen Lux, Gemesis CEO and president, said, "There has been a noticeable increase in consumer demand for cultured diamonds and we feel that the time is right to increase our capacity. This plan will help meet the growing demand and give more consumers access to fancy color diamonds."

The construction will commence immediately and when completed will enable Gemesis to increase production capacity by more than 50 percent.
